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
INTRODUCTION

The emergence of new words, meanings and terms is the result of the creativity of the speakers which cannot be avoided. Things like this are very common among teenagers, with full creativity often produce a new utterance and combine various variations daily of language communication. The use of code switching, code mixing, interference (incorporating foreign language elements into Indonesian words or vice versa), borrowing foreign terms, and using slang both orally and in writing have become the informal language styles of young people today.

As one of the variations of language that is often used in association, we often

find slang in the communication of social media users. According to Chaer & Agustin in Antoro (2018), slang is created and used by certain social groups to interact internally so as not to be known by others. This is in line with the understanding of language that language is the main communication tool for interacting, expressing opinions and information, or as self-identity (Kridalaksana in Aslina. 2007). Slang language originally appeared as a variation of language by certain groups or regions used during socialization. Therefore, the slang of an area will be different from other regions. But now, the use of slang words has become more widespread and spread beyond the group.

Slang is usually used by teenagers who represent certain social groups who have a desire to express their aspirations as a form of self-affirmation, self-expression





and self-realization (Izmaylova et al, 2017). Slang has become a trend among teenagers and one of the factors that contributes to spreading this is social media. Fishman (1972) defines the use of slang is very temporary, slang has no definition precise and definite and can only be understood by the group or the society to which the language Originates. The use of slang is not only used when communicate directly or interface, Communication can also be via the internet which allows slang to develop more rapidly and Disappears faster because of the language used tends to change according to development era. The language that is often used by the community is an easy language, not bound by rules, moderate trending. Research on slang, of course, has been done a lot. Budiasa & Savitri (2019) stated that most of the young generation today use slang in their conversations between close friends,

both orally and in writing. Meanwhile this study discusses the use of slang language due to the curiosity of researchers towards use of slang in YouTube.

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Fiki Naki Youtube account. This research was focused on slang. Data collection has been carried out since 18 April 2020. The researcher took 20 comments to analyzed.


The data comes from netizens comments that contain slang languages. Below are the data that researchers have obtained:




Analize: "BRO" is an abbreviation of the word brother which means brother. But here in slang, bro, it means friends/friends or close calls.




Analize: "dm" stands for "direct messages". The meaning of dm is direct private messages sent online. dm as it is used now can refer to a private message on a number of social media services.



Analize: The term" BTW " is actually an abbreviation of the phrase in English, which is "by the way".



Analize:" Be like" is a slang word that is often used by young people on social media. which means like, resembling.




Analize:" OMG", usually spoken when surprised, happy, or sad.



Analize: "ILY" stands for short and I Love You. a word used to express love.




Analize:" BAE "is another term used to define a lover or your partner or a person who is very important to your life, you could say bae is another name for the word boyfriend or lover.




Analize: "LMFAO" or Laugh My Fuckin Ass Of. Literally, this word can be interpreted as an expression of laughing out loud.

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
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
